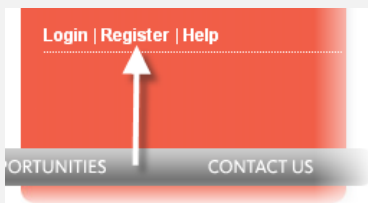


Getting started with tessituranetwork.com

The Tessitura Network website is the central hub for *all* things Tessitura: one-stop resources for using Tessitura, communication about important Network-related events, and a place to share with others in the Tessitura Network community.

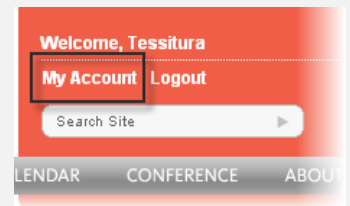
Step 1: Register

99% of the site content is behind login, available only to members of the Tessitura Network (you!), so please register.



Registration is simple. Navigate to tessituranetwork.com and find the *Register* link in the upper right of the homepage. Fill out the fields (note that your email address must be your **work email address**) and submit. The site will send you an email activation link (check your spam folders if you don't see the email in your inbox). Click through on the activation link and you're all set!

Tip: Once logged in, visit the *My Account* link (upper right utility bar) to fill out your profile and upload an avatar.

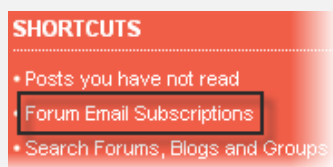


Step 2: Explore the Community

What is the Tessitura Network, really? A community. A network of leading arts and cultural organizations sharing a common technology platform, Tessitura Software. The Tessitura Network community is about collaboration and the website is here to help you do that.

Navigate to the *Community* tab and you start to get an idea about the power of the Network. Here you can communicate with other Tessitura users on a wide range of Tessitura and business-specific topics (*Forums*), keep up to date on the latest from Network leadership (*Blogs*), collaborate in small groups around like-minded themes (*Groups*), find others in the community (*Directory*).

Tip: Let the website keep you up to date. Sign up for email or RSS alerts so you don't miss a single post. Email alerts settings can be found through the *Forum Email Subscriptions* link in the sidebar, in the Shortcuts menu. We hope you'll set most or all of them to Yes to be notified of each post. Email alerts also allow you to reply from your email to the forums, like a list-serve.



Also, RSS feeds can be found at the bottom of each of the forum thread listings and throughout the site.

Step 3: Answer a question you have about Tessitura software

This website is **THE** definitive place to find Tessitura Software learning resources. Here's some of what you will find:

It stands for Real Simple Syndication; it is a way for you to receive syndicated updates about content that you're interested in... without clogging up your inbox or opening a web browser! You can have RSS feeds delivered straight to Outlook 2007, other email clients or any number of free RSS readers, such as Google Reader or even your browser—Internet Explorer 7 and above and Firefox and Safari all have facilities for subscribing to RSS feeds.
